





Boho Crochet Earrings

SKILLS USED

Adjustable Ring
Chain Stitch
Slip Stitch
Single Crochet
Double Crochet
Slip Stitch Through Top of Stitch
Blocking

EXPERIENCE LEVEL:

MATERIALS AND TOOLS

Sample uses Presencia Perle Finca #3 Color #2627

Crochet hook: 2.75mm (size C)

Yarn needle - Colonial Knitter's Needles, item #08111

Yarn snips

Fishhook earring findings (1 pair) - 21mm fishhook with 3mm ball and 4mm coil with open loop



STITCH GUIDE

Slip stitch (sl): Insert hook into indicated st, yo and draw up a loop through st AND loop on hook at the same time.

Single Crochet (sc): Insert hook into indicated st, yo and draw up a loop (2 loops on hook), yo and draw through 2 loops on hook.

Double Crochet (dc): Yo, insert hook into indicated st, yo and draw up a loop (3 lps on hook), [yo and draw through 2 loops on hook] 2 times.

Slip stitch through top of stitch (slst-tost): Insert hook into top of next stitch coming out behind the post of the stitch, yo and draw up a loop.

STITCH GUIDE

Adjustable Ring: Wrap yarn twice in ring around index finger, ensuring the yarn tail falls behind the working yarn. Grip ring and tail firmly between middle finger and thumb. Insert hook through center of ring, yo (with working yarn) and draw up a loop, ch 1 to secure the loops, work stitches of first round in ring created by the wraps. After the first round of stitches has been worked, pull gently but firmly on yarn tail to tighten ring.

INSTRUCTIONS

EARRING - MAKE 2

Round 1: Make 10 sc in adjustable ring (see Special Techniques), join round with slst-tost in first sc made - 10 sc.

Round 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, ch 3, (sc in next st, ch 3) 9 times, join round with slst-tost in first sc made, sl st in ch-3 sp - 10 sc, 10 ch-3 sps.

Round 3: Ch 1, sc same ch-3 sp as sl st just made, ch 3, (sc in ch-3 sp, ch 3) 6 times, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, dc 3 times in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, dc 3 times in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, cut yarn leaving tail for weaving in and join round with duplicate stitch (see Special Techniques) – 8 sc, 6 dc, 8 ch-3 sps, 2 ch-1 sps.

FINISHING

Block earrings by first steaming earrings then placing pins in each ch-3 space being sure to shape the ch-3 space between the two sets of 3 dc into a point. Steam again then let set to dry and cool. Remove pins and attach earring findings to top of earrings as pictured.

Wear... look cute as all heck and get used to saying "Thanks! I made them!"



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SPECIAL TECHNIQUES


Adjustable Ring

- 1. Wrap yarn twice in ring around index finger, ensuring the yarn tail falls behind the working yarn.
- **2.** Grip ring and tail firmly between middle finger and thumb. Insert hook through center of ring,
- 3. yo (with working yarn) and draw up a loop,
- 4. ch 1 to secure the loops,
- **5.** Work stitches of first round in ring created by the wraps.
- **6.** After the first round of stitches has been worked, pull gently but firmly on yarn tail to tighten ring.













Finish Round with Duplicate Stitch

Work the last stitch of the round and cut yarn, leaving about a 6"-10"/15-25 cm tail.


- 1. Draw the last loop still on the hook all the way through the last stitch made, until the tail passes through the stitch. Thread the tail through a yarn needle.
- 2. Skip the next stitch (first stitch of round). With the yarn needle, run the end of the tail under both loops of the next stitch and pull the yarn through.
- 3. Insert the needle back through where the tail originally came from (last stitch made) and behind your work.
- 4. Snug the yarn to cover the skipped stitch with duplicate stitch just made, matching the tension of the other stitches.
- 5. Working from the back of the stitches, bring the yarn up through the center of the duplicate stitch just made AND the underlying stitch.
- 6. Skip the next stitch. Run the end of the tail under both loops of the next stitch and pull the yarn through.
- 7. Insert the yarn needle back through where the tail originally came from (duplicate stitch AND underlying stitch).
- 8. Snug the yarn to cover the skipped stitch with duplicate stitch just made, matching the tension of the other stitches. Weave in tail
